



The following is a summary of actions taken by the Texas FFA Board of Directors during the fourth quarter meeting, held on Friday, June 5th, 2026, in Stephenville, Texas.

- Approved the minutes from the third quarter board meeting.
- Approved the addition to Policy 32.4 by clarifying that all Area Officers must attend the full SLC and National Convention.
- Approved Policy 1.3 clarifying who can serve as an FFA advisor and what their responsibilities are.
- Approved Policy 1. 3 (d) stating that Texas FFA will not backdate memberships without proper documentation and will not backdate more than one year.
- Approved Policy 4.3 (d) (1) Clarifying the requirements for New Chapters.
- Approved 9 New Chapters.
- Approved Policy 26.9 and 26.12 edits by removing "6" photographs from the Ryan Mott and John Justin applications and adding "one" applicant headshot.
- Approved that all CDE awards will be finalized by August 1. No changes, reorders, or replacement awards will be ordered after this date.
- Approved CDE Rule 8 of the Eligibility & Participation section that members can only participate in one State CDE per day, and multiple Area CDEs if times do not conflict.
- Approved the addition of CDE Rule 2 to the Materials, Equipment, and Calculator Policies that contest stickers must remain visible at all times.
- Approved the amendment to CDE Rule 5 in the Scoring, Tabulation and Awards section that Texas FFA Competitive Events Coordinator will keep all CDE scan sheets for 48 hours after the appeal deadline.
- Approved the amendment to CDE Rule 2 in the Contest and Conduct section stating that qualifying state teams may not visit the State CDE site, or any facility or building related to the university host.
- Approved removing At Large CDE positions.
- Approved amending LDE Rule 4 stating that Area Coordinators will certify that state teams are accurate.
- Approved striking LDE Rule 3 in the Judges for Events section.
- Approved moving Here By the Owl Award policy to Policy 40.5.
- Approved the addition of Policy 40 regarding the Star Administrator and Star Counselor Awards.



- Approved removing language from Policy 22 to require the Texas FFA Scholarship to be administered through the Texas FFA Roster.
- Approved that Texas FFA Scholarship applicants must meet 3 invitational requirements located in Policy 22.
- Approved the Texas FFA Scholarship question bank.
- Approved the addition to Policy 20.4 (g) (8) regarding the number of state officer candidates at the area and district level.
- Approved 3 new Board of Director candidates.
